Technical Business Rules: Perkins V Postsecondary Accountability Measures

The Perkins program is the primary federal investment in career and technical education at both the secondary and postsecondary levels.

What is the Purpose of the Perkins Grant?

The Perkins Grant provides secondary and postsecondary schools with funding to support career and technical education programs.

The Perkins law requires that states report annually on several core indicators of performance. The performance indicators are calculated at both the local agency and the state levels. (MDCPS Adult and Technical Intake Form (Data Input Form FM-3999)




